

## GLOSSARY

Format - like paper books, ebooks are made by different organisations in different ways, and the result is digital book files that require different software and/or devices to read. The simplest way to tell what format an ebook is, is to look at the <u>extension</u> of the digital book file - the part of the filename to the right of the dot (eg. greatbook.mobi. This would be a <u>Mobi</u>pocket book). In practice, ebook vendors often provide easy ways to purchase and download books directly to reading devices, which mean readers only have to understand what formats to buy, and the website does the rest. IN some cases vendors only sell one format, so there is no format choice to make.

DRM - stands for Digital Rights Management. There are many types of DRM, but all are encryption methods applied to digital files to make unlawful copying or sharing very difficult.
